What Interns Do

Interns participate in every part of the creative process, including:

- Assisting students with theatre games, character work, blocking, and learning lines
- Receiving training in songs, monologues, scenes, and performance skills
- Performing in select program events
- Supporting technical theater: costumes, sets, lighting, sound, and box office
- Helping set up and strike shows throughout the summer

Interns explore multiple areas of theater and can focus on their interests as they grow.

Intern Levels

College Interns

College Interns work closely with directors, choreographers, and designers, receiving guided training in lesson planning, rehearsal support, and youth leadership. Returning college interns may take on increased responsibility and receive rising stipends.

Student Interns (High School, age 14+)

Student Interns are members of the CCYT Performance Company and participate in a grant-supported program that includes modest stipends for performances, touring shows, and fundraisers.

Summer Responsibilities

All interns:

- Attend daily morning stand-ups
- Assist with drop-off and pick-up
- Stay engaged and present during rehearsals
- Support directors and staff by taking tasks off their plates
- Participate in workshop productions (Funshop, Kids, Jr.)
- Work backstage, tech, or box office for all shows and special events
